<u>PFEFFER NEWS</u>: In a recent phone conversation with the Quimby Pipe Organ Company, they reported that the restoration work in their shop is going well. About 90% of the metal pipes have been cleaned and all of the rotted leather on the wind reservoir (the "lungs") of the instrument have been replaced. Conversation is continuing about the repair/refabrication/replacement of the broken and missing finials at the top of the organ case spires. It is estimated that the reinstallation of the pipework will occur during the first part of July. In the meantime, electrical repair work will be taking place, as well as the installation of a small air conditioning system to help cool the loft during the warmer months.

<u>CONCRETE WORK AT ST. CECILIA</u>: During the past week, work began to repair the concrete steps that were poured last year. Unfortunately, the contractor that had been hired did not perform the work as specified in the signed contract (hence the uneven size of steps, the narrowness of ramp, etc.). With the assistance of diocesan legal council and under threat of legal action being taken, the contractor has finally decided to correct the deficiencies. Thank you for your patience. – Fr. Secrist
