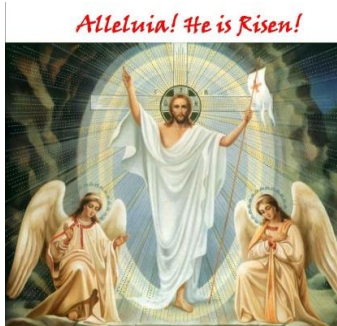

Dear Friends in Christ,

Home missions are those U.S. Dioceses facing fragile financial situations, vast distances, or difficult terrain that significantly affects the ability to offer the most basic pastoral programs.

The Diocese of Lubbock in Texas is geographically isolated but has a growing Catholic population. It is ethnically diverse and vibrant in its faith, but a prolonged drought is putting strain on the farming and ranching communities. All 25 counties in the Diocese have high poverty rates.

The Church is called to minister to all who suffer—but in Lubbock, priests face additional challenges. Many pastors are assigned to two or more parishes across great distances. Your support of the Catholic Home Missions Appeal helps educate new seminarians for the Diocese of Lubbock.
