Elm trees: Father noted that several trees around the Church and School are dead or dying. Discussion followed about what should be done and what to replace them with and when and how many would be affected.


The next meeting is scheduled for September 19, 2018 at 7:15 p.m. at the Parish Center.


The meeting adjourned at 8:45 p.m. with Father leading with a closing prayer.
