A NOTE FROM YOUR PASTOR:

At St. Thomas the Apostle, the T & J Restoration Company has begun the exterior cleaning, tuck-pointing and waterproofing of the main church. Two years ago, their company tuck-pointed and waterproofed the church bell tower. Once the main body of church has been waterproofed, then we can begin addressing the water damaged plaster and paint in the interior. A grant from the A.J. Schwartze Foundation has provided the majority of the funding for this restoration project.

At St. Cecilia, further cleanup work has taken place behind the Parish Center. The Don Schneiders Construction Company has removed some problematic trees and prepared a new concrete pad for the new propane tanks which are replacing the two that were damaged during the June 6th storm.
