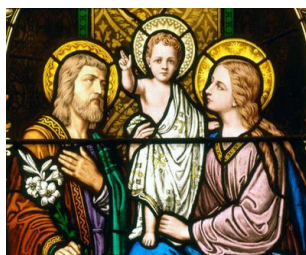

**PASTORS MEDITATION: MERRY CHRISTMAS. A SAVIOR IS BORN FOR US TODAY:**

Christmas reveals to us the goodness and love of God, its message calls us from selfishness to a renewal of the worship of the one true God, who alone is worthy of a complete and total dedication. God not only knew what he wanted, he also knew what he was doing. He was making it clear that he alone was God. He did not have to rely on mighty armies to conquer evil in the world. He did not have to appeal to philosophical wisdom for the spread of his truth; he did not have to rely on any human government to bring about justice and peace. God made his saving power present in a Jewish infant, Jesus Christ, an act which appears to be folly in the eyes of the wise of this world. He chose to pour out that salvation upon mankind through the blood of Christ poured out on the cross, an act which seems to be a weakness in the eyes of the powerful of this world. God did what he did as a sign that we attain salvation, not by our own human efforts but by his free gift in Jesus Christ. Christmas is appealing to us because it makes God so close to us. Jesus is indeed Emmanuel, God with us in a simple human way. But we should not allow the simplicity and humanness of Christmas to dull our senses of wonder and awe. We should do well to imitate Joseph and in his humility because we are really much less worthy than he, a great saint, to take part in so holy a reality. Humility does not mean to back off in fear from the mystery of Christmas but rather it should move us to praise God for his goodness in calling us to be so close to him in the person of his son made flesh. The birth of Jesus Christ should fill our hearts with wonder and praise. To feel the joy of Christmas, we must have the faith to believe that the Almighty God himself came into our world in flesh of an infant. To experience the thrill of Christmas, to derive benefit from Christmas, we have to receive Jesus Christ as God's special gift to us, to open our arms and embrace him, to let him become a part of our lives, as Mary did. We all must be humble enough to admit that we need Jesus, that without him we cannot make any sense of our lives or accomplish any worthwhile purpose. All happiness which should be a part of Christmas can be ours if we join Mary in saying "my spirit finds joy in God my savior, for he has looked upon his servant in her lowliness."
