**PASTOR'S MEDITATION: DECEMBER 29, 2019 SUNDAY: THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY & JOSEPH & HAPPY NEW YEAR.**

Receive my many greetings and Congratulations upon Christmas celebrations; we thank God above all for giving us a gift of His son and such a perfect day of Christmas.

Let me take this opportunity to thank you so much dear parishioners of St. Thomas and St. Cecilia Meta for my **CARDS, NOTES AND CHRISTMAS GIFTS ESPECIALLY THE SUPPORT TOWARDS MY JOURNEY AND VACATION**, you are such sweet parishioners, I love you dearly and I will be missing you so much while I take vacation, but I will always keep you in my prayers as you pray for me as well.

On the last Sunday of the year, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. We are here to offer all the members of our own families on the altar for God's blessing.

We need to learn lessons from the Holy Family: The Church encourages us to look to the Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph for inspiration, example and encouragement. They were a model family in which both parents worked hard, helped each other, understood and accepted each other, and took good care of their Child so that he might grow up not only in human knowledge but also as a Child of God.

The husband and wife attain holiness when they discharge their duties faithfully, trusting in God, and drawing on the power of God by prayer, Amen.
