<u>THE PENITENTIAL SEASON OF LENT</u> begins on **Ash Wednesday**, **February 14** (Valentine's Day) this year. On a day typically reserved for chocolates, candies and meals shared with a loved one, Holy Mother Church asks us all to fast, pray and abstain from meat. Take it as an opportunity to pray with each other and grow deeper in a true and abiding love of God.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the two obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics in the whole year. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence from meat. Catholic peoples from time immemorial have set apart Friday for special penitential observance by which they gladly suffer with Christ that they may one day be glorified with Him. This is the heart of the tradition of abstinence from meat on Friday where that tradition has been observed in the Catholic Church.

<u>OPERATION RICE BOWL</u>: This Lent, our community will have the opportunity to participate in the Catholic Relief Services Operation Rice Bowl. Operation Rice Bowl is a faith-in-action program that helps us experience Lenten spirituality by living in solidarity with people in need around the world.
