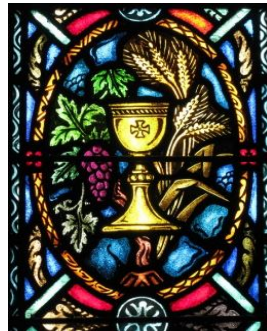

**A NOTE TO PARISHIONERS AT ST. THOMAS THE APOSTLE:** it is greatly appreciated that our tower bells be used to summon the faithful to weekend Masses. As you are probably aware, the mechanical clock in the tower strikes every quarter hour (top of the hour, quarter past, half past and quarter til). Sometime around Christmas, the bells were rung during the time that the strike mechanism was attempting to work and this resulted in two of the four strike hammers in being sheared off. In order for the strike mechanism to function properly, the bells need to be standing still and not moving. So, please ring the bells **10 minutes** before Mass is to begin, but not before, so that the bells are in a resting position. Many thanks to Dale Herigon for finding a machine shop to reconstruct the hammers and for his work in re-installing them in the tower. – **Fr. Secrist**

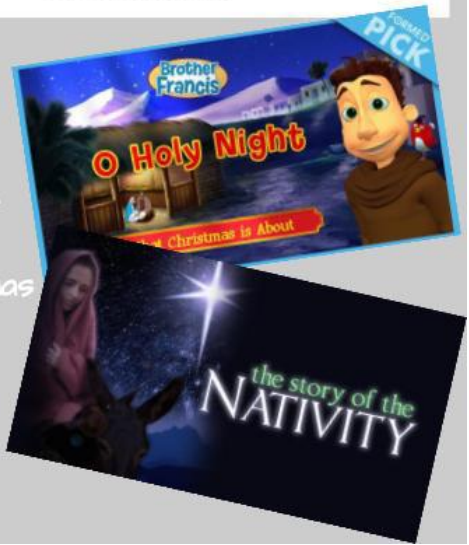

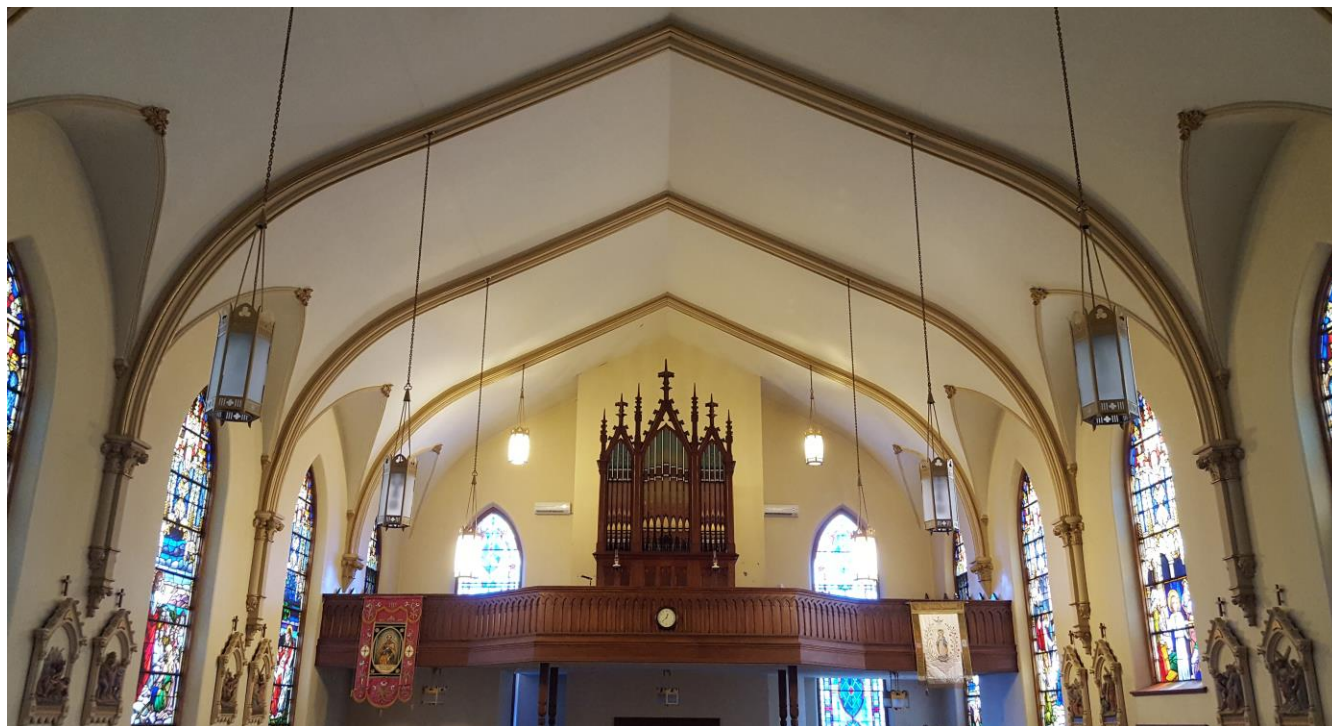

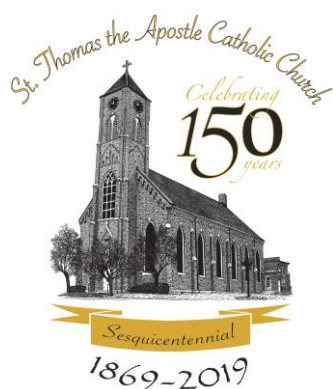
