LENTEN REGULATIONS:

Abstinence: All who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

Fasting: Everyone, from the celebration of their 18th birthday to their 59th birthday, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means eating only one full meal each day. Two other partial meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken; but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. Voluntary fasting on other weekdays of Lent is highly recommended. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, neither the law of fasting nor the law of abstinence obliges. These are minimal penitential practices and should not be lightly excused. If in doubt, please consult your parish priest.

Other recommended forms of fasting, as regards alcoholic drink, needless television, video games, Internet use, and social entertainment, are of true spiritual value and strongly encouraged.

<u>Almsgiving</u>: The act of giving to the poor, in the most ancient tradition of the Church, is an expression of penance, a witness of fraternal charity, and an expression of Lenten conversion. Catholics are encouraged to support generously the charitable works of the whole Church: through regular stewardship to their parish and support of charities.

<u>Prayer</u>: To deepen one's love for Christ, Catholics are urged to participate in the sacramental life of the Church during Lent by attending daily Mass and frequenting the sacrament of Reconciliation.

BREAKING THE SILENCE OF ABUSE: As a Diocese, we are committed to breaking the silence of abuse. When someone is reporting abuse, we must acknowledge their pain and how difficult it is to talk about it. False allegations are very rare. Our initial response to someone who is disclosing abuse for the first time must be compassionate. For those who need to report abuse, encourage them to contact our Victims Assistance Coordinator, Jacqueline Baldwin, (573-694-3199) and to make use of the appropriate State of Missouri hotline (1-800-392-3738) or the Attorney General's clergy abuse online form. The St. Cecilia Parish Pastoral Council meeting was held on Tuesday, January 17. Those present were Dusty Stegeman, Lydia Hurst, Shirley Bock, Janice Schanzmeyer, Cordel Schroeder, Katy Werdehausen and Doris Stumpe. Father Leonard was still out on vacation so was not present. The meeting opened at 6:40 p.m. with a prayer.

Dusty reported that no one has contacted him about interest in being on the Stewardship Committee. It has been listed in several bulletins. They are still going through the Stewardship forms received and entering into a spreadsheet. Only a small number have been returned. Doris will be placing all others that were not picked up into the mail.

Doris gave a brief update on the account balances and mentioned that details will be in an upcoming bulletin.

Lydia stated the Worship Committee will be having a meeting soon to discuss details for the Lenten season.

Janice has been in contact with the photographer used for the parish directories. It would be at least April before the photographer would be available. After discussion on the time it would take to put together the details in the book, the committee decided an early fall timeline would be best for planning purposes.

Cordel purchased a new freezer for the parish center from St. Elizabeth TV and Appliance for \$379 and it has been set up in the parish center. Doris will be sure the bill gets paid.

Cordell had stopped to get pictures of the two bathrooms in the Rectory and brought the pictures along to the meeting. There has still not been any bids so discussion continued on if it would be beneficial to have the bathrooms stripped so a contractor could come in and do the remodel work quickly.

There had been a large water break in front of the priest's house. Doris reported that Ruben Wieberg has repaired this.


There was discussion on snow removal off the parish lot. There were a couple names of local individuals that may be interested, the committee will be in contact with them to see if they find anyone interested.
