

No cobblers, please, and please label your pies. We are known for our homemade pies, so we encourage each family to do their part.

Homemade Bread: Donations of homemade bread will be needed this year. Each household is asked to donate two-three loaves of sliced bread.

<u>Country Store</u>: Any baked good (breads, cakes, pies, cookies, brownies, etc.), home canned foods, jellies, fresh fruits and vegetables sell very well. Please help bake for the country store.
