**PASTORS MEDITATION: THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST: CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY** (Ex. 24:3-8, Heb. 9:11-15, Mk. 14:12-16, 22-26)

The last two precious gifts given to us by Jesus are the Holy Eucharist as our spiritual food on Holy Thursday and Jesus' mother Mary as our spiritual mother on Good Friday. Corpus Christi is the celebration of the abiding presence of a loving God as Emmanuel, God with us, in order to give collective thanks to our Lord for his living with us in the Eucharist. The feast also gives us an occasion to learn more about the importance and value of the "Real Presence" so that we may appreciate the Sacrament better and receive maximum benefit from the Eucharist

We believe in the "Real Presence" of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist because 1) Jesus promised it after miraculously feeding the 5000. 2) Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist during his Last Supper. 3) Jesus commanded his disciples to repeat it in his memory. 4) "Nothing is impossible for God."

We explain the real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist by: "**transubstantiation**" which means that the substance of the consecrated bread and wine is changed to the substance of the risen Jesus' glorified Body and Blood by the action of the Holy Spirit, and its accidents (like color, shape, taste etc.), remain the same.

Instead of the lamb's blood, Jesus offered his own Divine/human Body and Blood, and instead of sprinkling us with blood, Jesus put it into our hands as food and drink: "Take ... eat ... this **IS** my Body which will be given up for you" (He did not say "This represents my body"), and "Take ... drink ... This **IS** ... my Blood, the Blood of the new and eternal Covenant, which will be poured out for you and for many...." (nor did He say, "This represents my blood...").

Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist both as a sacramental banquet and a sacrificial offering (a Sacrament and a sacrifice). As a Sacrament, a) the Eucharist is a visible sign that gives us God's grace and God's life and, b) as a Meal, The Eucharist nourishes our souls. As a sacrifice a) the Eucharistic celebration is a re-presentation or re-enactment of Jesus' sacrifice on Calvary, completed in His Resurrection. b) We offer Jesus' sacrifice to God the Father for the remission of our sins, using signs and symbols.

Dear friends let us appreciate the "Real Presence" of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, by receiving him with true repentance for our sins, due preparation and reverence.

Let us be Christ-bearers and conveyors: By receiving Holy Communion, we become Christ-bearers as Mary was, with the duty of conveying Christ to others at home and in the workplace, through love, mercy, forgiveness and humble and sacrificial service. Let us offer our lives on the altar along with Jesus' sacrifice, asking pardon for our sins, expressing gratitude for the blessings we have received and presenting our needs and petitions on the altar. **Have a blessed week! ### **St. Thomas the Apostle Parish Council Minutes - May 25, 2021**

*PPC Goal: Develop a more inclusive sense of community in our Parish by encouraging the growth of our relationships with each other and with God.*

**Members Present:** Jackie Prenger, Theresa Veit, Alan Reinkemeyer, Barb Graessle, Brian Luebbering, Mark Luebbering, Bob Schellman, Leroy Heckemeyer Jan Carter and Father Leonard Mukiibi.

**New Members:** Julia Cassmeyer, Jacob Graessle, Fred Boessen and Dunja Wieberg.

The meeting was opened at 7:05 pm with a prayer by Father Leonard.

- **Principal's Report (Leroy)**
- Field Day was May 14 and was done in-house.
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation was Tuesday, May 18<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm. Father celebrated Mass and there was a small reception and video in the gym.
- The last day of school was May 20<sup>th</sup>. Pre-school graduation was held that day.
- St. Thomas has been approved for the Emergency Assistance for Nonpublic Schools (EANS) in the amount of \$62,650. The money is being used for cleaning materials, textbooks, technology such as laptops, printers, headphones etc..
- We are looking to starting school next year on Wednesday, August 18 with the last day scheduled for Thursday, May 19, 2022. How we open school is still up in the air but hopefully after the summer, we can open as close to normal as possible.

**Financial Committee Report:** There was no report from the Finance Committee.

#### **Worship/Christian Education:**

- We need to write a grant to pay for the FORMED subscription. Mr. Heckemeyer offered to help pay for the subscription with some funds he has.
- The Bishop's decree stated that the dispensation from Mass will end on June 1, 2021. Each parish can make decisions about distancing and masks. The PPC decided to remove all ropes, the tape for distancing will be removed from the floor. We will continue to use the basket in the center of Church for envelopes. We will resume the offertory but the hosts will be covered. Father and Communion Ministers will continue to sanitize hands and use masks.
- The feast of Corpus Christi is June 6<sup>th</sup>. The K of C will be the honor guard. Lisa will be decorating and there will be three altars. Jackie will put something in the bulletin about it.

#### **Social Concerns:**

- The committee did not have a formal report but acknowledged that they need to resurrect their efforts to bring the mentoring program to fruition.
- There was a discussion about people needing to sign up with the parish if they are a wage earner so they can receive their envelopes. Dunja will put something in the bulletin and on Facebook to remind parishioners to do this.

#### **Administration Report:**

- The new sound system is in and completed in the Parish Center.
- There is still some electrical work to be done in the bell tower.
- Mark commented that it would be nice to have a full-time maintenance person since we have several buildings to maintain. The parish should consider.
- Brian shared an update from the Church Renovation Committee. The Church will be totally stripped of all pews, pictures statues, etc. starting on August 9<sup>th</sup> and lasting for two weeks. We will be using all of the parish storage areas. All Masses will be held at St. Cecelia as the entire church will have scaffolding. The Diocese approved a 5 year loan and the pledge drive will be starting soon. Painting will start in early September and the project will go through Christmas. The sound system will be done, there will be new carpeting, electrical lighting. Brian is getting designs for the side altars.

#### **Pastor's Report (Father Leonard)**

- Father Leonard thanked old and new members for their service.
- Father will be on retreat at the end of June.
- We have received approval from the Diocese for almost all of our projects.
- Annette, our organist is resigning as of May 31<sup>st</sup>. We are looking for a replacement.
- We will continue to live stream until our live streaming license expires which is March 2022.
- We are hosting a Totus Tuus program this year.
- Father said some of the parishioners have volunteered to paint the living room in the rectory and he is very grateful for that.

#### **New Business: Picnic**

- We will have a picnic this year and we will keep the drive thru that was used last year. There was some discussion about continuing with the serving lines or return to family style. The decision to do one or the other will depend on the work force we have available. The picnic committee members are: Larry Lueckenoff, (chair), Lisa Lackman, TJ Loethen, Sandy Kliegel and Phil Akin.
- There was a concern raised about continuing to bring snacks to the quilters. Jackie will talk to Emily Luebbering to get more information.
- There is a new form on the web site for people who want to use the church for any reason. The form is also in the parish office.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, July 20, 2021 at 7 pm in the school library.
