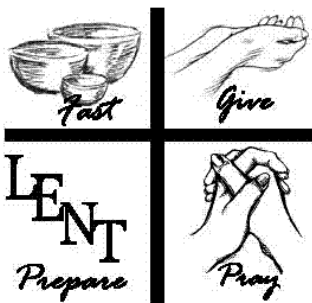

#### **LETTER FROM BISHOP GAYDOS**

Dear Friends in Christ,

"Behold, I stand at the door and knock." (Rev. 3:20). Next weekend, our Diocese will take up The Catholic Relief Services Collection (CRSC).
