IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

Everyone's help is needed on Sunday evening cleaning and dismantling work areas. Even if you are not a chair person, it is very helpful if you stay for a few minutes and help clean up. Since the shifts rotate each year, you only have clean-up duty every other year. Clean up includes washing all pots, pans, dishpans, cookers, steam tables and putting away supplies. The dishwashers are very busy washing all the serving ware from the tables and the committee has already worked 3 full days. Any help you can offer is greatly appreciated!

- If your name is not listed and you would like to work, please contact a committee member above as soon as possible.
- If you cannot work your assigned shift, please trade with someone and tell your chairperson about the change.

If you are able to help clean up Sunday evening or Monday morning at 8:00 am, it is welcomed, needed, and appreciated!

Chairpersons are a very important part of the process. Many of you have served in this capacity for many years and your work is greatly appreciated. For those that are new to the role, here are a few reminders:

- Chairpersons are responsible for their work areas. This includes setting up the work area and putting up stands, getting supplies, and doing prep work on Friday evening or Saturday if needed. Our goal is to have everything ready by 2:00 pm on Saturday. This gives us time to handle any last-minute items.
- Chairpersons are also responsible for ensuring their work areas are cleaned, trash is removed throughout the day, and the area is dismantled and washed before you leave on Sunday evening.
- **Chairpersons should contact all workers prior to Sunday. The committee would like a list of people who do not show up to work and/or would like to be moved to a different job. This information is helpful for the next year.**

ADDITIONAL PICNIC NOTES:

Pies: A reminder that each household is asked to donate three or more homemade pies (lemon, cherry, peach, apple, gooseberry, blackberry, blueberry, pecan, pumpkin, sugar free pies, angel food cake, cream pies, cookies bars or cupcakes are acceptable). No cobblers, please, and be sure to label your pies. We are known for our homemade pies, so we encourage each family to do their part.

Homemade Bread: Donations of homemade bread will be needed this year. Each household is asked to donate two-three loaves of sliced bread.

Country Store: Any baked good (breads, cakes, pies, cookies, brownies, etc.), home canned foods, jellies, fresh fruits and vegetables sell very well. Please help bake for the country store. Baking begins Friday at 1:00 pm and Saturday at 6:00 am.

The Country Store needs large and X-large aluminum pie pans for rolls. Also, if you have fresh or canned fruit, juice or jelly, or other items to donate to the country store, please contact Lucy Suthoff (477-3430), Donna Luebbering (477-3318) or Cathy Schroeder (496-3213).

Grand Raffle: Grand Raffle Tickets are on the table behind the last pew in St. Thomas church. Extra raffle tickets are in the entrances of church and at B&K. Sold tickets may be returned in the collection basket in an envelope marked "raffle" or on Picnic Day to the Grand Raffle Stand.

Advertising: Picnic and quilt flyers are in the entrances to church. Please take some and distribute them. Your assistance in spreading the word is very important to the success of our picnic.

Meat Donation: Meat Donation Envelopes are provided in the August offertory packet. Each envelope holder is asked to donate \$5.00 to offset the cost of meat for the picnic.

Craft Stand: Any items you can contribute to the craft stand are appreciated.

Food Donations: Don't forget! We need tomatoes and cucumbers for the meal. Please bring to the hall or call by Thursday August 16th if you have tomatoes and cucumbers to donate. Please DO NOT REFRIGERATE YOUR TOMATOES if at all possible!

If you have other items to donate such as potatoes, eggs, milk, cucumbers, onions, cash, or other, please call Greg or Joyce. The hall will be open Thursday evening, August 16th, all day Friday the 17th and Saturday the 18th. If you need another time, please call Greg or Joyce.

Grocery bags and gallon ice cream containers: If you have extra grocery bags or gallon ice cream buckets, these can be used in carry-outs, country store, and craft stand.

Cake Walk: Anyone interested in donating a cake of any kind (with no refrigeration required) for the cake walk, would be greatly appreciated and may contact Tina at 477-0175.

Kitchen Sales: If there is any extra chicken and beef, it will be sold after 8:00 pm in the kitchen area. There will be a sign-up sheet and the leftover food. There will be a suggested donation and will be distributed in order of who is signed up on the list. If you are interested in left over vegetables, please bring your own containers.

To ensure our Parish Picnic is a success we ask everyone to do the following as well as the items listed above:

1. Work assigned time (or more if possible!).
2. If you are a stand chairperson or a head waitress, you have additional responsibilities noted on the work list. Your extra time is certainly appreciated.
3. Sell raffle chances – return all sold and unsold chances to the grand raffle stand on picnic day.
4. The sauerkraut workers will also dice and cook potatoes for kraut on Saturday.
5. Help clean up Sunday. All work areas should be cleaned by the shift workers. This includes washing pots (and any other items), taking care of trash throughout the day and putting away supplies and equipment before you leave. School is in session on Monday so the more we do Sunday evening, the better.
6. Help clean up on Monday. Clean up begins at 8:00 am. Again, any help is greatly appreciated.

Additional notes:

Parking will be available in Gilbert Schellman's field. Please use Steve Schellman's driveway. Please do not park in those areas reserved for handicapped visitors. We want to ensure our visitors have a pleasant experience and there is ample parking.

We will use the number system for dinner tickets. All tickets must be purchased on the day of picnic with ticket sales starting at 10:00 am. Adult carry out meals are available in the school cafeteria.
